1. WINTERHUNT, DATE, LOCATION AND TRANSPORTATION:

- a. The outfitter will provide a hunt from the _____ day of the _____ month, 201____ year, through to the _____ day of the _____ month, 201____ year, inclusive unless there are circumstances arising beyond our control, examples: Weather, Automated Licensing System, Clients not arriving as per scheduled or for any other reason over which we have no control, from which there will be no refund from the outfitter for missing days of your scheduled hunt.

The hunt contains:

Day 1. Transport to camp, departure around 13.00

Day 2-5 hunt from camp

Day 6 Transport to town, departure around 10.00

- b. During the hunt the Outfitter will provide hunting transportation only from the first day of your scheduled hunt until the last day of your scheduled hunt, not including any travel before or after your hunt.
- c. Your hunt will be in area 3 south of Kangerlussuaq.

2. GENERAL DISCRPTION OF THE EXPERIENCE:

- a. Check the game species you wish to harvest: **Musk-ox** _____, **Reindeer** _____,

I am a Non-Hunter _____.

- b. The terrain in the hunting area may include flatland, hills, mountains and/or open fields/areas.
- c. Transportation within the hunting area may be on foot, by quad/ATV/snowmobile or by vehicle or whichever the outfitter or guide deems to be the best method to harvest your game.

- d. In order to enjoy this outfitted hunt, you should be in average physical condition.
- e. Unless previously arranged, each hunter must be willing to share a guide with another hunter if requested by the outfitter.
- f. Please notice, its Greenland, its winter, its cold. The temperature can be down to around minus 25 celsius during nighttime in the hunting season. And about minus 10-15 in the daytime.
- g. The more detailed description of the hunt is on the webpage www.trophy-hunting-greenland.dk, and you are required to read all info listed there.

All of the above activities will be conducted according to the Code of Ethics according to the home rule government regulations.

3. EQUIPMENT/FACILITIES/SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE OUTFITTER:

Our camp is a larger cabin out in the huntingarea, older and primitive, but heated and comfortable.

Sorry, no electricity provided for cameras and phones, etc. Primitive toilet, no washing facilities, and no cell phone coverage in the camp area. But we bring satellite phone for emergency.

- a. Meals and lunches during the days of the scheduled hunt only, and evening day 1 and breakfast day 6.
- b. Field dressing, skinning and quartering of game when required and delivery of your trophy from the harvested area to the hunting camp and back to Kangerlussuaq town.
- c. Its allowed to bring 5 kg of meat from musk-ox or reindeer frozen when flying to Denmark, and no special permit or anything is needed. We help with cutting and packing if you want to bring meat. Please tje regulation yourself for bringing the meat to other EU countries from Denmark.
- d. Packing and sending trophy as frozen by ship to Aalborg in Denmark, including required health certificate from Greenland. All trophies are sent to First Class Trophy.

4. SERVICES YOU MUST PROVIDE:

- a. Before your arrival to your hunting camp and before your final payment of your hunt you must have **signed and returned the required, Trophy Hunting Greenland, Assumption of Risk and Release form Liability Agreement.**
- b. Before your arrival to your hunting camp and before your final payment of your hunt you must have **signed and returned, Trophy Hunting Greenland, required Hunting Contract. For your reference and for customs you agree to print off a copy of this hunting contract and carry it with you.**
- c. Before transport to the hunting camp you agree to pay any and all remaining funds for the cost of your hunt in, **Euro or DK/kr, but we prefer prepayment by bank transfer.**
- d. Tip for our hunting guides is welcome, but not necessary. Its all up to you, no –blame of any kind. Tip are not a natural part of Greenlandic culture and are not expected, but of course appreciated.
- e. Any and all related shipping costs to and from Denmark, and all costs of taxidermy fees and any related shipping costs to and from the taxidermist for the cape, antlers and/or trophies.
- f. You will be responsible for your own arrival and departure to/from Kangerlussuaq including any and all travel time including land, water or air transportation and/or any car/truck rentals.
- g. You will plan to arrive at the morning of day 1of the hunt, around 10.00. After the return to Kangerlussuaq you can stay free of charge for 3 days on Kangerlussuaq Youth Hostel, meals not included.
- h. You will be responsible to bring the following equipment: Rifle, ammunition, towel and all toiletries, cold weather clothing, rain gear, used walking/winter boots, your required passport, your country's hunting license, and all other personal items that may be required by yourself for a comfortable experience.

- i. Rifles, warm clothes and boots can be rented.
- j. If you want to stay at a hotel or any other place after the hunt besides the youth hostel, its at your own expense. We can help with contact info if needed.

6. CANCELLATION NOTICE AND REFUND POLICY:

- a. Deposits are non-refundable but may be transferred to another party for the same year and dates only. If your outfitter cancels your hunt for any reason all funds paid will be refunded.

7. CLIENT ACCEPTANCE OF LIABILITY AND RISK:

- a. You are fully capable of participating in this trip and are willing to assume the risk of injury as your responsibility.
- b. You accept that all expenses for evacuation, and treatment at the health service in Greenland are at your own expense, And it's up to me to have a insurance for that.
- c. It must be recognized that any hunting activity is potentially hazardous.
- d. It is essential that all lawful directions and advice of the Outfitter/Guide or guide be followed at all times. No exceptions.
- e. It is important to recognize that dangerous handling of firearms will not be tolerated.
- f. You will not hold the outfitter/guide or your guide responsible for any injury or fatality that may occur or expenses arising there from.
- g. **Passports** - You are aware that a passport is required by the Greenlandic customs to enter Grenland.
- h. It is important to remember that we have only one rule, **use respect**. This includes but is not limited to our Fish and Wildlife Laws of Greenland, the cleanliness of camp facilities and the discard of garbage in the nature or on the hunting campgrounds.

- i. Be reasonable with your hunting expectations, your success depends a lot on you. Although the success rates are very high in the area and most clients have an opportunity to take game, at least +95% success rate, and until now our hunters have had a 100% success, the outfitter gives no guarantee that game will be located and the client is not assured of any game.
 - j. Legibly provide the name and phone number of an individual to contact in case of an emergency.
 - k. Alcohol is allowed, but limited to a few drinks after the days hunt. No drinking while hunting, and drunk behavior is not tolerated under any circumstance, neither in camp or at the youth hostel. In minus 25 degrees it can be very dangerous.
